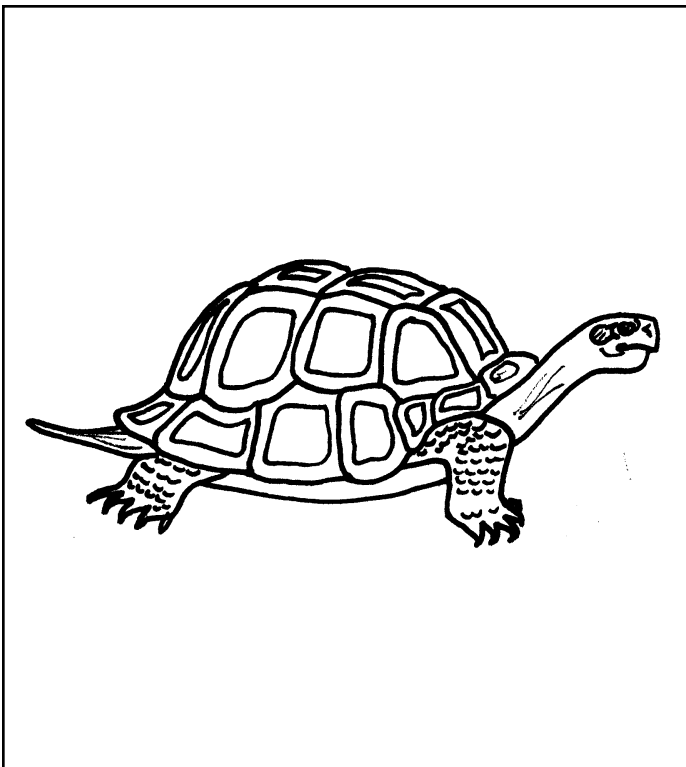


forelegs

These are shorter than the hind legs and are designed mainly for balance. They also help push food into the frog's mouth.

neck

This joins the head with the inner body. Its length and flexibility enables the tortoise to withdraw its head into its shell.
