Language Activity 4: Identifying Pictures of Familiar Objects in a Book

3. Join the pages with round metal rings to form a booklet.
4. To reinforce left-right orientation, place each picture on the right-hand page, leaving the left-hand side blank.
5. Change the images occasionally to add interest.



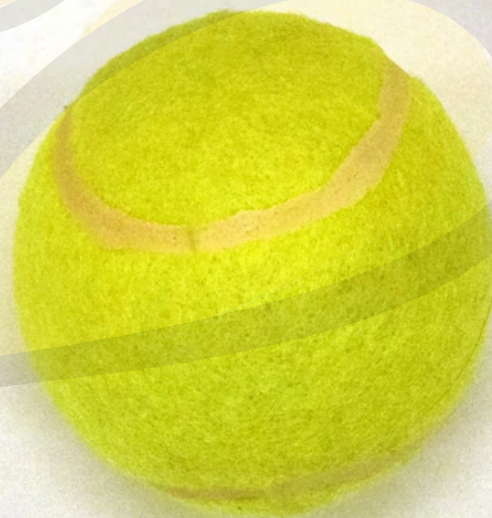
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Cognitive Activity 5: Distinguishing Same from Different Extension 2
